For your convenience, the hotel is bordered
by Ohio Street – gateway to I-90/94, which serves
both Chicago's Midway and O'Hare
International airports – and minutes from
Union Station and Northwest Metro rail
stations.

Directions From O'Hare International Airport...
Follow Route 90 East to Route 90/94 East. Exit on
Ohio Street. The hotel is on the corner of Ohio
and State Streets. Proceed around the block to
the entrance on Grand Avenue, or enter the North
Bridge garage and take the elevator to the lobby
of the hotel.

Distance from hotel: 16 mi.

Drive time: 20 min.
